# ORDER FOR SURRENDER OF LICENSURE AND CONSENT TO THE SAME

Leda Reid, PA-C ("Respondent") elects to permanently waive any right to a hearing and appeal with respect to this Order for Surrender of Licensure; admits the jurisdiction of the Arizona Regulatory Board of Physician Assistants ("Board") and findings of fact as stated herein; and consents to the entry of this Order by the Board.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of physician assistants in the State of Arizona.
- 2. Respondent is the holder of license number 2304 for the performance of health care tasks in the State of Arizona.
- 3. The Board initiated case number PA-22-0054A after receiving Respondent's self-report that she had been terminated from her practice group after taking two tablets of a controlled substance at a Hospital without permission.
- 4. On August 25, 2022, the Executive Director issued Respondent an Interim Order for Physician Health Program Assessment requiring Respondent to schedule an Assessment with a Board approved Assessor within three days of the Order and complete the Assessment within 10 days ("Interim Order").
- 5. Respondent failed to comply with the Interim Order, and requests surrender of licensure based on her retirement from the performance of healthcare tasks.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over Respondent.
- 2. The Board possesses statutory authority to enter into a consent agreement with a physician assistant and accept the surrender of an active license from a physician assistant who admits to having committed an act of unprofessional conduct. A.R.S. § 32-2551(P)(2).
- 3. The conduct and circumstances described above constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-2501(18)(j) ("Committing any conduct or practice that is or might be harmful or dangerous to the health of a patient or the public.").
- 4. The conduct and circumstances described above constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-2501(18)(ee) ("Violating a formal order, probation agreement or stipulation issued or entered into by the board or its executive director.").

### **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Respondent immediately surrender license number 2304, issued to Leda Reid, PA-C for the performance of healthcare tasks in the State of Arizona, and return her certificate of licensure to the Board.

- 4. The Order is not effective until approved by the Board and signed by its Executive Director.
- 5. All admissions made by Respondent in this Order are solely for final disposition of this matter and any subsequent related administrative proceedings or civil litigation involving the Board and Respondent. Therefore, said admissions by Respondent are not intended or made for any other use, such as in the context of another state or federal government regulatory agency proceeding, civil or criminal court proceeding, in the State of Arizona or any other state or federal court.
- 6. Notwithstanding any language in this Order, this Order does not preclude in any way any other State agency or officer or political subdivision of this state from instituting proceedings, investigating claims, or taking legal action as may be appropriate now or in the future relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent, including but not limited to, violations of Arizona's Consumer Fraud Act. Respondent acknowledges that, other than with respect to the Board, this Order makes no representations, implied or otherwise, about the views or intended actions of any other

state agency or officer or political subdivisions of the State relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent.

- 7. Upon signing this agreement, and returning this document (or a copy thereof) to the Board's Executive Director, Respondent may not revoke the consent to the entry of the Order. Respondent may not make any modifications to the document. Any modifications to this original document are ineffective and void unless mutually approved by the parties.
- 8. This Order is a public record that will be publicly disseminated as a formal disciplinary action of the Board and will be reported to the National Practitioner's Data Bank and on the Board's web site as a disciplinary action.
- 9. If the Board does not adopt this Order, Respondent will not assert as a defense that the Board's consideration of the Order constitutes bias, prejudice, prejudgment or other similar defense.
  - 10. Respondent has read and understands the terms of this agreement.
