11 On June 5, 2024, this matter came before the Arizona Medical Board (“Board”) for consideration of the Administrative Law Judge’s (“ALJ”) proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order with regarding to Khursheed Haider, M.D., (“Respondent”). Assistant Attorney General Elizabeth A. Campbell represented the State. Assistant Attorney General Ben Norris was available to provide independent legal advice to the Board.

12 The Board, having considered the ALJ’s Decision and the entire record in this matter, hereby issues the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

13 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

14 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for licensing and regulating the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.

15 2. On February 13, 2024, the Arizona Board issued a Complaint and Notice of Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on March 21, 2024.

16 3. No representative appeared for Dr. Haider at the scheduled hearing-time and the matter was convened in his absence at about 9:15 a.m.

17 4. The Board presented the testimony of Board Investigator, Daniela Schulten, and submitted exhibits 1 through 9.



1 5. Given Dr. Haider’s egregious behavior and his failure to appear at the  
2 duly noticed hearing, Dr. Haider has demonstrated that he is not amenable to regulation  
3 by the Board. Consequently, Dr. Haider’s license should be revoked.

4 **ORDER**

5 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Board’s Order of Summary Suspension of Khursheed  
6 Haider, M.D.’s License No. 62055 is affirmed and that Khursheed Haider, M.D.’s  
7 License No. 62055 is revoked.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1451(M),  
9 Khursheed Haider, M.D., be charged \$387.53 for the cost of the formal hearing. Dr.  
10 Haider shall pay the Board \$387.53 by certified funds within 90 days of the effective  
11 date of this Order.

12 **RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW**

13 Respondent is hereby notified that he has the right to petition for a rehearing or  
14 review. The petition for rehearing or review must be filed with the Board’s Executive  
15 Director within thirty (30) days after service of this Order. A.R.S. § 41-1092.09(B).  
16 The petition for rehearing or review must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting  
17 a rehearing or review. A.A.C. R4-16-103. Service of this order is effective five (5)  
18 days after date of mailing. A.R.S. § 41-1092.09(C). If a petition for rehearing or  
19 review is not filed, the Board’s Order becomes effective thirty-five (35) days after it is  
20 mailed to Respondent.

21 Respondent is further notified that the filing of a motion for rehearing or review  
22 is required to preserve any rights of appeal to the Superior Court.
