ORDER FOR SURRENDER OF LICENSE AND CONSENT TO THE SAME

(Non-Disciplinary)

Robert A. Mackin, M.D. ("Respondent"), elects to permanently waive any right to a hearing and appeal with respect to this Order for Surrender of License; admits the jurisdiction of the Arizona Medical Board ("Board") as well as the facts stated herein; and consents to the entry of this Order by the Board.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.
- 2. Respondent is the holder of license number 17570 for the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.
- 3. The Board initiated case number MD-21-0118A after receiving a report indicating that Respondent may have a health condition that impairs his ability to safely practice medicine.
- 4. Respondent has retired from the practice of medicine, and his license expired effective September 28, 2022, but the expiration is stayed pending the outcome of this Board's investigation pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-3202

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

 The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over Respondent.

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2. The Board possesses statutory authority to enter into a consent agreement with a physician and accept the surrender of an active license from a physician who admits to being unable to safely engage in the practice of medicine. A.R.S. § 32-1451(T)(1).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Respondent immediately surrender License Number 17570, issued to Robert A. Mackin, M.D., for the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona, and return his certificate of licensure to the Board.

- 7. This Order is a public record that will be publicly disseminated as a formal non-disciplinary action of the Board and will be reported to the National Practitioner's Data Bank and on the Board's web site as a disciplinary action.
- 8. If the Board does not adopt this Order, Respondent will not assert as a defense that the Board's consideration of the Order constitutes bias, prejudice, prejudgment or other similar defense.
