# ORDER FOR SURRENDER OF LICENSE AND CONSENT TO THE SAME

Lindsay A. Regali, M.D. ("Respondent"), elects to permanently waive any right to a hearing and appeal with respect to this Order for Surrender of License; admits the jurisdiction of the Arizona Medical Board ("Board") as well as the facts stated herein; and consents to the entry of this Order by the Board.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.
- 2. Respondent is the holder of license number 67946 for the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.
- 3. The Board initiated case number MD-24-0436A after receiving notification that Respondent's clinical privileges at a Hospital in Virginia had been suspended due to concerns that Respondent may have a health condition that impaired her ability to safely practice medicine.
- 4. Based on the report, the Executive Director issued a Confidential Interim Order for Physician Health Program Assessment, which required Respondent to complete a Physician Health Program ("PHP") Assessment within 10 days from the date of the Order.
- Respondent advised that she would be unable to complete the Assessment in a timely manner, and requested an Interim Practice Restriction in lieu of completing the Assessment.

- 6. Respondent entered into an Interim Consent Agreement for Practice Restriction effective June 10, 2024.
- 7. Respondent did not undergo the PHP Assessment as required by the Interim Order, and has requested surrender of licensure based on her decision not to practice medicine in Arizona.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over Respondent.
- 2. The conduct and circumstances described above constitute unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1401(27)(s) ("Violating a formal order, probation, consent agreement or stipulation issued or entered into by the board or its executive director under this chapter.").
- 3. The Board possesses statutory authority to enter into a consent agreement with a physician and accept the surrender of an active license from a physician who admits to having committed an act of unprofessional conduct. A.R.S. § 32-1451(T)(2).

#### **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Respondent immediately surrender License Number 67946, issued to Lindsay A. Regali, M.D., for the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona, and return her certificate of licensure to the Board.

- 4. The Order is not effective until approved by the Board and signed by its Executive Director.
- 5. All admissions made by Respondent in this Order are solely for final disposition of this matter and any subsequent related administrative proceedings or civil litigation involving the Board and Respondent. Therefore, said admissions by Respondent are not intended or made for any other use, such as in the context of another state or federal government regulatory agency proceeding, civil or criminal court proceeding, in the State of Arizona or any other state or federal court.
- 6. Notwithstanding any language in this Order, this Order does not preclude in any way any other State agency or officer or political subdivision of this state from instituting proceedings, investigating claims, or taking legal action as may be appropriate now or in the future relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent, including but not limited to, violations of Arizona's Consumer Fraud Act. Respondent acknowledges that, other than with respect to the Board, this Order makes no representations, implied or otherwise, about the views or intended actions of any other

state agency or officer or political subdivisions of the State relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent

- 7. Upon signing this agreement, and returning this document (or a copy thereof) to the Board's Executive Director, Respondent may not revoke the consent to the entry of the Order. Respondent may not make any modifications to the document. Any modifications to this original document are ineffective and void unless mutually approved by the parties.
- 8. This Order is a public record that will be publicly disseminated as a formal disciplinary action of the Board and will be reported to the National Practitioner's Data Bank and on the Board's web site as a disciplinary action.
- 9. If the Board does not adopt this Order, Respondent will not assert as a defense that the Board's consideration of the Order constitutes bias, prejudice, prejudgment or other similar defense.
  - 10. Respondent has read and understands the terms of this agreement.
